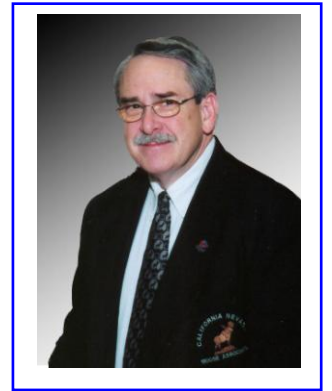

Happy Monday and Welcome To June 2013:



Also included are the Membership results for May.

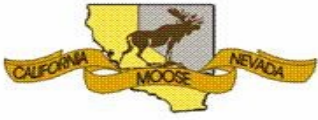

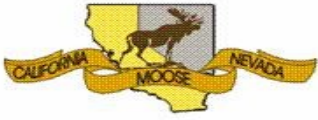

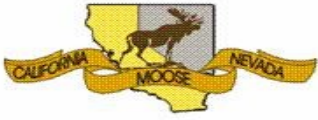
For years, our lodges have asked, "Why doesn't the Membership Department have Reduced or No Application Fee for the entire year? The Lodges could really support that type of program." As I stated early in May, this program is supported at a cost of \$2,000,000 to the Membership Department. It was installed on a trial basis to see if it would be a success and could it possibly continue past this year. While our lodges have had more than a month to get the program up and running, the early results are far less than those guaranteed by our officers and members.

The "Sponsor Two Candidates" program to receive a free year's dues may also be short lived. The program has had several years to take hold and the results are very disappointing. Unless our lodge officers Promote the program and our members respond with the necessary results, it could be coming to an end.

WILL RECEIVE "2 BONUS POINTS"
TOWARD THIS YEAR'S 5-STAR AWARD**

Because of recent changes to the Moose of the Year recognition program, the Moose of the Year forms are not being sent to the lodges until June 3rd (they will be sent electronically). In previous years, the forms were sent through the mail in late April or early May. In previous years, the Five Star Program has given 2 Bonus Points for those Moose of the Year forms received at Moose International prior to June 1st. This was over and above of the 10 regular points for submitting the forms by the due date of July 1st.

The change in the 5-Star Program is that any lodge that transmits their Moose of the Year forms and is **received at Moose International prior to 8pm (pacific time) on June 15th**, will receive the 2 additional points.

Get your Past Governors together immediately to make the decision, who the lodge should thank for going the extra mile, to benefit his lodge. The only "requirement" for being nominated for this award is that he be a member whose dues are current. Every lodge has a member that **DESERVES TO BE** for this "Recognition." It doesn't cost the lodge one cent to nominate a member. Not even the cost of a stamp!! **"JUNIOR PAST GOVERNOR, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO GET THIS DONE. START IMMEDIATELY !!**
